**Student Awards Program  
April 2005**

**Guidelines**

1. Two awards will be established per year, one for each ACS National Meeting. Each award will consist of a cash prize of \$500, a certificate signed by the Chairs of the Division and the Student Awards Committee, and a complimentary ticket to the Division Social event, which is usually a dinner jointly organized by the Fuel and Petroleum Chemistry Divisions.
2. The Fall National Meeting award will be called the Ellis Fields Memorial Student Award, honoring a former Division Chair and ACS President. The Spring National Meeting award is currently not named.
3. All bonafide graduate and undergraduate students—irrespective of nationality, affiliation, age, or gender—submitting *and* presenting a paper in any of the Division symposia (including those co- and jointly-sponsored by the Division) at ACS National Meetings are eligible for these awards. To be eligible, the student must be the presenting author.
4. Students must apply for the award using an [application form](#) that will be available on the Division web site. The application form must be endorsed by the student's advisor and must be accompanied with a copy of their preprint. In case of electronic submissions, the student's advisor should forward the application package, including the preprint.
5. The only criterion for selecting an awardee will be the technical quality of his/her preprint. Students presenting papers at symposia co-sponsored by the Division but not requiring preprints must submit preprints to be considered for the award.
6. Awards may not be given if satisfactory recipients are not identified by the Student Awards Committee.
