The Award is administered by the Division of Agricultural and Food Chemistry of the ACS and sponsored by International Flavors and Fragrances, Inc. The award was established in 1971, and the first recipient was Dr. A. L. Elder who accepted the award at the 166th meeting of the ACS in Chicago, August 1973.

Purpose

To recognize and encourage outstanding contribution(s) to pure and/or applied agricultural and food chemistry.

Nature

The Award consists of \$3,000, an engraved plaque, and an allowance to cover the traveling expenses of the awardee to the meeting at which the Award is presented.

Rules of Eligibility

A nominee must have made (1) outstanding application of chemistry and/or chemical technology to the solution of agricultural or food problems of importance to the nourishment and health of mankind, or (2) outstanding contributions to the advancement of pure and/or applied agricultural and food chemistry. Special consideration shall be given to independence of thought and the originality shown, or to the importance of the work when applied to the public welfare or the needs of humanity. The nominee must be actively engaged in the line of work for which the Award is made. The Award shall be granted without regard to sex, creed, or nationality.
