A. Comment on the following (noting strengths and, if applicable, deficiencies):

1. New Activities/Projects

There was one new activity cited this year which was the Establishment of the Bulgrin Award. This is an additional education award that honors High School Chemistry Teachers. The Wyoming Section has a very strong awards program including the "State Science Fair Awards", "Outstanding High School Chemistry Teacher Award", "Sara Jane Rhoads Award", "E.R. Schierz Scholarship", just to name a few. The Section is to be commended for an excellent job on these recognitions.

4. Section Thrusts/Priorities/Goals:

There are no programs to address activities and programs to facilitate career development of chemical professionals. This is one area which requires some activities. Another deficiency is in programming to encourage women, minorities, and persons with disabilities. There are a number of activities and programs addressing the needs of students and education in the chemical sciences as well as encouraging participation of students and young chemists-great job!! No programs to encourage participation from industrial members.

2. Section Administration/Member Involvement:

There are sufficient number of committees for running a Section of this size. There are no subsections or topical groups though. The Section is fully represented at both National ACS Meetings.

The majority of the section is in the Educational area and there are very few industrial members. There should be an effort to reach out to the industrial side of the Section as much as possible through programming/seminars. The membership is mainly in the Education field and most services are towards these members. There are several events which address the general public through ACS tour speakers and other talks.
